Since it was first awarded back in 1963, the Brookville Traveling Trophy has had many legendary paddlers engraved on its nameplates, including 5 Olympians. Faced with no space left to engrave on the original plates, CanoeFest organizers went to the original woodworker of the trophy and sought a solution. The result is fantastical, with a new base that makes this trophy the largest, heaviest trophy of its kind in on earth!

In another move to return to our roots, and re-energize the canoe-racing sport, the trophy will be awarded to the best time from the aluminum or standard classes. No longer does one need to invest in an expensive boat to take home the gold. You can practice, compete, and win, with a boat you can rent from one of our 2 great liveries, Morgan's or Whitewater.

Another change in 2009, are later starting times for all 3 CanoeFest races. The Biathlon now starts at 11 am, the Recreational (wave 1) starts at 11:30, and the USCA-Rules Race (the race for the Trophy) starts at 1 pm. This race will also be a mass, on-water start, so you can compete head-to-head with the best paddlers of the region!

So start practicing, and come on down to Brookville, June 27, for CanoeFest, and be a part of paddling history!
